Bucket Feeding

- **Mixing Rate:** 150g of milk replacer mixed with water to make up to 1 litre of mixed milk (15% solids).
- Calves under 28 days of age should be fed a minimum of 4 litres per day split into 2 feeds.
- CalfStart Advance can be used in a once a day feeding system from 28 days of age providing calves are consuming enough solid feed to constitute a second feed. For once a day feeding increase the concentration to 200g per litre from 28 days and reduce the volume to one 3 litre feed. For once a day feeding with whole milk add 50g of powder per litre. Calf Management

- Colostrum management is crucial and should be fed as soon as possible.
- Give concentrate from day 1 onwards, give in small amounts and no more than is consumed.
- Renew the feed regularly, calves can be weaned when they eat >1.5kg of concentrate per day.
- Supply roughage in the form of chopped straw.
- Ensure that calves have enough fresh drinking water at their disposal from 1 day of age.
